"Man looks at the outward appearance, but the Lord looks at the heart." 1 Samuel 16:7 (NIV)

When Jesus came from heaven to take on our humanity He was an ordinary looking man. Isaiah 53:2 says, "He had no beauty or majesty to attract us to him, nothing in his appearance that we should desire him." (NIV) So Jesus was an ordinary looking person Who did not turn heads when He walked by.

However, it was when He spoke that suddenly people realised that He was no ordinary mortal. One day some police were sent to arrest Jesus but came back without him. The officials asked them why they did not capture our Lord. John 7:46 quotes the police as saying, "No one ever spoke the way this man does..." (NIV)

As you struggle with the problems you face in this life, it is so important to really hear Jesus speaking. You need to ponder His words. If you get past all the various descriptions of Jesus and listen to what He says, rather than what others say about Him, you will be truly blessed. Look up Jesus' words in the Gospels of the Bible.
